Application process

Students must first complete the expression of interest form. Upon completing the EOI form, the VET commitment to pay and training provider forms will be available for the chosen course from the student hub.

For students wanting to undertake stackable VET outside of the Adelaide Hills Student Pathways network (such as AIE, The French Beauty Academy, Clip Joint, Queensford College), you will need to go to the relevant training provider's website and complete their digital application form.

In this enrolment process, please use the school's VET email: dl.0783.vet@schools.sa.edu.au. This will allow us to be informed of your application.

Once you have done this and received confirmation of your acceptance into the course, please email the dl.0783.vet@schools.sa.edu.au confirming the following.

1. The name of the qualification for example, Partial Certificate I in Automotive
2. The name of the Training Company for example: TAFE SA, Clip Joint, AIE
3. The course costs (include both training and consumables as separate amounts, if applicable).
4. The delivery dates of the course for example: every Thursday 9.00am to 3.15pm starting from 3 February 2025.

These documents must be completed in full and submitted to the student hub by Friday, 13 September 2024, week 8, term 3.



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Subjects for 2025

Semester 1, 2025 timetables are usually finalised at the end of term 4, 2024. Upon notification of a student's acceptance into a VET course, families will be responsible for contacting Justin Saegenschnitter, Assistant Principal Curriculum via phone 8391 1599 OR email: justin.saegenschnitter202@schools.sa.edu.au to discuss any subject withdrawals to accommodate their VET course.

VET withdrawal

If a student withdraws from a VET course after it has begun, parents will be liable for the full amount of the course as charged by the training company.

Additionally, students will miss out on SACE credits they would have gained. This will impact their SACE pattern and require them to study additional subjects.

Stackable VET costs

The following generic costs apply for stackable VET courses. The VET commitment to pay must be received to finalise ALL vet applications:

1. Administration fee \$150.00 invoiced term 1, 2025.
* School card recipients pay only \$100.00.
2. Course and consumable cost invoiced in term 1, 2025
* School card recipients are NOT subsidised.

Early term 4

Interviews will take place for some courses if applicable.

Mid to late term 4

Students will be notified of VET course acceptance.

New applications for stackable VET courses will be received for semester 2, 2025.
